



Stockport Radio Society “Double Sapphire” Award

As part of our 90th anniversary celebrations and to promote communication between members by radio, a new society operating achievement award is to be launched.

During the calendar month of June 2010, any current member of Stockport Radio Society who can show they have accumulated the required number of points, may apply for the “Double Sapphire” award which is in the form of a skillfully crafted certificate and available in two classes.

Programme Requirements

- Contacts allowed between 00.01 UTC 1st June 2010 and 23.59 UTC 30th June 2010.
- Award open to all 2010 members of the Society, that is those whose subscription covers the current year and is confirmed in the society's records on 1st July 2010 as having been paid.
- Contacting any SRS member on any band on any mode scores 1 point. A member can only be claimed once.
- Contacting any SRS club callsign – G6UQ, G8SRS or M5MDX – scores 5 points. Each club station can only be claimed once.
- Contacting Society President Harry Arnfield G3LX – scores 5 points as a society callsign.

The two classes of award for contacts are as follows:

- **Silver** – 25 members or 20 different members + 1 society callsign or 15 members + 2 society callsigns = 25 points.
- **Gold** – a further 25 different members, or 20 different members + 1 different society callsign or 15 different members + 2 different society callsigns = 25 points. (Total 50 points. Silver (25 points) + further 25 points)

Submissions

- Submit a log extract showing Date; Time; Callsign and Mode for all QSOs claimed to:
- Alan Gurnhill G0ROW by 31st July 2010.

Opportunities to work society callsigns & members.

There will be plenty opportunities to pick up the required points during the month.

- All three Stockport Radio Society callsigns (G6UQ, G8SRS & M5MDX) will be on the air on 2 metres and 80 metres and where possible 40 metres.

- The Thursday evening 2 Metre net looked after by Alan G0ROW using the club callsign G6UQ.
- The RSGB 80 Metre Club Championships between 19.00 to 20.30 UTC.
 - 7th June - DATA.
 - 16th June - CW.
 - 24th June - SSB.
- The Tuesday evening RSGB VHF/UHF Activity contests where G8SRS will be activated by Chris 2E0CBS & Will M0GYZ.
 - 1st June – 2 Metres
 - 8th June – 70 Centimetres
 - 22nd June – 6 Metres

You will be able to pick up a lot of points then so it can be done.
